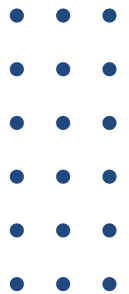

Director's Report

Summer has arrived!

June began with the launch of this year's Summer Reading Program! Participants can earn ice cream, supplied through our partnerships this year with Clark's Burger and Wild Flour, they can win a free book & day pass to the Meeker Rec Center, and be entered to win our NEW weekly prizes and grand prizes!

ServPro installed the temporary canopy the first weekend of June, in preparation of the roof replacement, which started on the 10th. The canopy catches any dust/debris that is released from the ceiling during construction. Opening the doors and Servpro's air filters helped with the gluing fumes well enough that we were able to stay open during the gluing process. Patriot Heating and Cooling will return to complete work in the Reference and Children's Rooms once the roof is done. They have recommended that we get more work done above the Study Rooms to make the HVAC system more efficient.

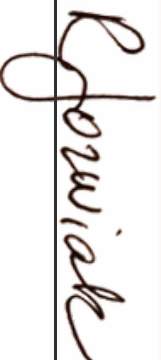
