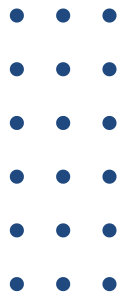

Librarian's Report

May began with my attendance at the annual Colorado Library Director's Retreat. This year it was held in Granby. These retreats are extremely beneficial as they allow directors to connect, share, and gain knowledge and ideas from peers.

I completed a few trainings this month, I have attached the certificates to this month's report. The trainings included Budgeting and Finance for Public Libraries hosted by the University of Michigan, Learn to Write Effective Policies and Procedures hosted by Pryor Learning, and Supporting Domestic and Sexual Violence Survivors at Your Library hosted by WebJunction. I also attended a webinar with the Special District Association on the upcoming deadline for compliance with Colorado House Bill 21-1110. I met with our website host Streamline afterwards to learn how best to ensure our website and uploaded documents are in compliance of the bill. I have also been meeting periodically with Employers Council on the Compensation Analysis and Benefits study they are conducting for us. Results for both will be presented by Employers Council at this month's meeting. Staff will be attending a customer service training in Meeker on May 29th.

We have been busy gearing up for this year's Summer Reading Program. The theme is Color Our World, and so we plan on some art focused programming to accompany the program. Since the Sweet Shop is no longer in business we have partnered with Wendll's and Clark's to continue our ice cream coupon tradition. More options for patrons and partnering and supporting more local businesses is a great plus to us!
