

# Unaccompanied Adults Policy

The Children's Room of the Meeker Public Library ("**Library**") is intended for children under the age of 12, their parents or responsible adult caregivers, and for those browsing the children's book collection.

To ensure the safety of children, individuals who are not accompanied by a minor and who, in the judgment of library staff, do not appear to have a legitimate reason to be in areas designated for children may be approached by staff and asked to relocate to another area of the Library.

Adults may not participate in programs organized for children and teens unless parental/caregiver attendance is required or the program is offered as a family program. Staff may ask uninvited adults to leave children or teen programs.

Adults who do not comply with this Policy may be asked to leave the Library and, if necessary, police may be notified.
