New display shelving has given the Juvenile, Young Adult, and Children's room an update. These displays will showcase and better highlight the newest arrivals into these sections. We have already had great feedback from patrons on this shift.

We have also implemented Dewey Decimal dividers into the Juvenile section to help patrons find what they are looking for. I plan on purchasing a set for the Adult Non-Fiction as well.

There was an issue this month with the entrance into the community room from Main Street resulting in the door being out of service. Pinnacle Glass fixed the door and will also fix the handicap entrance into the courtyard at a later date. Kim's Plumbing is coming to look at the main water line after a leak was temporarily fixed to see what needs to be done.

Kid Librarian has been a hit! We have our first poster up in the Juvenile section and many applications to be the next. I hope this program will help promote the Juvenile books and get kids excited to read by seeing recommendations by their peers.

Hoopla is the newest addition to our digital resources. It includes ebooks, audiobooks, TV shows, movies, music, magazines, and Great Courses. We have had many inquires about this service, and I believe it will be a great resource. It should be up and running to the public soon.

A community survey has been released and I am currently collecting responses. I plan to keep the survey open for at least a few months to give plenty of time for residents to respond.

I have begun working on the Storywalk project and have met with the Rec District. I look forward to this partnership and getting a Storywalk into our community.
